## Fire Safety Month...

October is known as "Fire Safety Month". We will be doing fire drills twice a month throughout the year here at Holy Cross. During sing time in October, we will talk to the children about fire safety.

This is a perfect time to talk to your children at home about fire safety as well, plan a family meeting place, change the batteries in your smoke detectors and have a fire drill.

#### Halloween Parties, Parades and Trunk or Treat...

I have heard that Halloween is a very exciting and fun time at Holy Cross, and I am looking forward to celebrating it with everyone! On the day of your child's parade and party, please bring your children in their costumes and drop them off at their classrooms as usual. Parents will then head over to the North Parking Lot to take pictures. We will parade the children out with their class, walk by the parents, so that the children can show you their costumes, then head to our Trunk or Treat cars!

During the week of October 11, the teachers will hang up a "Party Sign-Up Sheet" outside the classroom. This gives you an opportunity to bring in something for the party. If you don't get an opportunity to sign up for this party, please don't worry, there will be many other opportunities during the year! While the party is for the children and teachers only, you are invited to the Parades. We hope you can join us!

#### Some important reminders;

~ If you would like to participate in our Trunk or Treating, please see me to sign up for a spot for your vehicle.

~ If the weather does not cooperate we will hold our parades inside the school.

~ If your child attends school on both Wednesday *and* Thursday, you are welcome to attend both parades or just choose one.

~ If your child does not attend on *either* of these days, you are welcome to bring them to the parade.

~ If your child normally leaves school at 11:30, they are welcome to stay until 12:00 on these days for the class party.

~ Please just pack a light lunch on the days of the parties.



At the end of each month, you will receive a tuition invoice by e-mail. Some of you have chosen to also receive a paper copy that will be sent home to you in your child's backpack. Tuition is due the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month (any payment received after the 10th will be charged a \$15 late fee). Please check the information very carefully and contact the office (732)255- 3112, if any of the information is incorrect. Please remember, if you are using extended care on a *permanent basis*, you will be charged the \$5.00/hr rate and that will be included in your monthly tuition. If you are using extended care on an *as needed* basis, you will be charged separately at the end of the month at the \$7.00/hr. rate. Please place your payment in the tuition boxes at the end of the hall by the front door or in the childcare room, or you can mail your payment to: Holy Cross Nursery School, 1500 Hooper Ave., Toms River, NJ 08753.

#### Attention: All Parents - Coughs, Sniffles & Runny Noses...
