Back to School Night ...

Don't forget, that we will be having "Back to School Night" on Thursday, November 16th. On Back to School Night all parents are invited to come and experience a typical day here at Holy Cross. There will be a session with the director, including a slide presentation starring the children of Holy Cross! You will also go to your child's class and listen to the teacher explain a typical day, while engaging you in some of the activities that your child experiences every day.

This event is for adults only so perhaps you can get a friend, relative or babysitter to watch your children. The evening generally lasts about an hour, and will start at **6:30 sharp**. If your child attends school on *Mondays, Wednesdays, and/or Fridays*, you will head to the Holy Cross Church Sanctuary for the first half of the evening, and then to your child's classroom. If your child attends school on *Tuesdays and/or Thursdays*, you will head to your child's classroom first, and then to the Sanctuary. If your child comes *5 days per week, or a combination of days*, please see your child's teacher, to see where she would like you to head first. We request that you do not use the evening to ask questions regarding your individual child. Individual conferences will be scheduled for January. The date for Back to School Night will be Thursday, November 16th.
