Fire Safety Month...

October is known as "Fire Safety Month". We did our first fire drills this week, and we will be doing fire drills twice a month throughout the year here at Holy Cross. During sing time in October, we will talk a little bit to the children about fire safety. This is a perfect time to talk to your children at home about fire safety as well, plan a family meeting place, change the batteries in your smoke detectors and have a fire drill. The Silverton Fire Dept. will be coming to visit us later in the year.

Halloween Parties, Parades and Trunk or Treat...

Halloween is a very exciting and fun time here at Holy Cross, and we are all looking forward to celebrating it with everyone! On the day of your child's parade and party, please bring your children in their costumes and drop them off at their classrooms as usual. Parents will then head over to the North Parking Lot to take pictures. We will parade the children out with their class, walk by the parents, so that the children can show you their costumes, then head to our Trunk or Treat cars!

During the week of October 9th, the teachers will hang up a "Party Sign-Up Sheet" outside the classroom. This gives you an opportunity to bring in something for the party. If you don't get an opportunity to sign up for this party, please don't worry, there will be many other opportunities during the year! While the party is for the children and teachers only, you are invited to the Parades. We hope you can join us!

Some important reminders;

- ~ If you would like to participate in our Trunk or Treating, please see me to sign up for a spot for your vehicle.
 - ~ If the weather does not cooperate we will hold our parades inside the school.
- ~ If your child attends school on both Tuesday *and* Wednesday, you are welcome to attend both parades or just choose one.
- \sim If your child does not attend on *either* of these days, you are welcome to bring them to the parade.
- \sim If your child normally leaves school at 11:30, they are welcome to stay until 12:00 on these days for the class party.
 - ~ Please just pack a light lunch on the days of the parties.



Tuition ...

At the end of each month, you will receive a tuition invoice by e-mail. Some of you have chosen to also receive a paper copy that will be sent home to you in your child's backpack. Tuition is due the 1st of each month (any payment received after the 10th will be charged a \$15 late fee). Please check the information very carefully and contact the office (732)255-3112, if any of the information is incorrect. Please remember, if you are using extended care on a permanent basis, you will be charged the \$5.50/hr rate and that will be included in your monthly tuition. If you are using extended care on an as needed basis, you will be charged separately at the end of the month at the \$7.50/hr. rate. Please place your payment in the tuition boxes at the end of the hall by the front door or in the childcare room, or you can mail your payment to: Holy Cross Nursery School, 1500 Hooper Ave., Toms River, NJ 08753.

REMINDERS:

- ~Please label all of your child's items that are brought to school, so that it is easier for everyone to keep track of their things.
- ~Please be sure to pack healthy snacks and lunches for your children! Also, be sure that all food is cut up (especially chokable items, like grapes and hotdogs), so that your children are able to eat them on their own.

~We have quite a few families that have asked us NOT to post their child's picture on Social Media...when you are taking pictures of your children, at any of our events, please remember to be considerate of all of our families, and only post your own child's picture on social media.

Please remember to never leave a child unattended in the car in the parking lot. If it is raining, or snowing (it'll be here before we know it!), or if you have a sleeping baby in the car, please let me know at the door. I'll be happy to accompany your child to their classroom, or if you are parked right by the door, I can watch your car for you.

Please return documentation for the influenza vaccine. All children under 5 in the state of NJ must have this completed by December 31, 2018, to be able to return to preschool in January.
