Weather and Health Watch...

Weather, temperatures, and snow/mud permitting, the teachers (especially full day classes) like to take the children outside, even if only for a walk. With this in mind, please dress your children for outside play (warm jacket, hat, mittens, a scarf and appropriate shoes for play).

'Tis the season to spread germs... *Please remember that your child should be fever and symptom free (vomiting, diarrhea, etc.) for 24 hours before they return to school.* Although a slight cough or runny nose is common, excessive coughing and/or discharge can spread germs quickly! We do appreciate a call or e-mail to let us know that your child will be absent, and a doctor's note is required to return to school following a contagious illness. It is important for everyone to do their part to help make our school environment as healthy for the children as possible..... Thank you so much for your continued cooperation!

Emergency Procedures and Lockdown Drills

As you all know, we held the first of our 2 annual Lockdown Drills in January, now required by the State of NJ Office of Licensing. The staff and I did everything in our power to make it as stress free and relaxed as possible for your children.....and we referred to it as an "Inside Drill" (as opposed to a Fire Drill, which would be an "Outside Drill"). Everything went incredibly smoothly, and all of your children did a wonderful job listening to their teachers!
