## Easter Parties & Egg Hunts

April 17 & 18, the children will have an Easter Party and an Easter Egg Hunt, with their class. There will be a sign-up sheet outside of each classroom, if you'd like to bring something in for their party.

We are asking that each child bring in 12 *filled* plastic eggs, *in an egg carton*. The teachers will hide all of the eggs, and each child will find 12 eggs, put them in their egg carton, and then bring their carton back home, with the 12 filled eggs that they have found! Your child's teachers will be sending home a list of ideas, for filling your plastic eggs

~ If your child does not attend school on either Wednesday or Thursday, please see your child's teacher about which day would be better for them to attend the class party and Easter Egg Hunt

~ If your child normally leaves school at 11:30, once again, they are welcome to stay until 12:00 on these days for the class party.

~ Please just pack a light lunch on the days of the parties.



Before your child holds a pencil and starts writing, you may want to do the activities listed below to strengthen the muscles in their arms, wrist, fingers, and hands.

- 1. Arm exercises: Arm circles, throwing a ball overhand and underhand, and holding onto a bar and hanging.
- 2. Wrist exercises: Laying on tummy and resting chin on hands while watching TV and/or hearing a story and painting at an easel.
- 3. **Finger exercises:** Picking up things with ice tongs and tweezers, doing finger rhymes, doing puzzles, playing with any kind of snap blocks, painting with a big paintbrush, drawing with big crayons and/or markers, finger painting, lacing, stringing, sewing and buttoning.
- 4. Hand exercises: Playing with play dough, silly putty, clay, and kneading flour.
- 5. When your child is ready to begin writing his/her name, PLEASE, teach them to use upper and lowercase letters and to start at the top!
