#### Weather and Health Watch ...

Weather, temperatures, and snow/mud permitting, the teachers (especially full day classes) like to take the children outside, even if only for a walk. We've had such a mild winter so far, that we've been able to take advantage of getting outside a lot! With this in mind, please dress your children for outside play (warm jacket, hat, mittens, a scarf and appropriate shoes for play).

'Tis the season to spread germs... *Please remember that your child should be fever and symptom free (vomiting, diarrhea, etc.) for* **24 hours** *before they return to school.* Although a slight cough or runny nose is common, excessive coughing and/or discharge can spread germs quickly! We do appreciate a call or e-mail to let us know that your child will be absent, and a doctor's note is required to return to school following a *contagious* illness. It is important for everyone to do their part to help make our school environment as healthy for the children as possible..... Thank you so much for your continued cooperation!

#### Emergency Procedures and Lockdown Drills

As you may know, we are required by the State of NJ Office of Licensing, to hold 2 Lockdown Drills (per session) per school year. We will be holding our first drills over the next week. The staff and I do everything in our power to make it as stress free and relaxed as possible for your children....and we refer to it as an "Inside Drill" (as opposed to a Fire Drill, which would be an "Outside Drill").

Along with doing drills, it is always important for a school to be prepared for any type of situation that may arise! With that in mind, we are in need of some emergency supplies, that we will hopefully never need to use!
